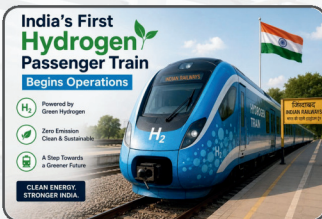

#### 1. INDIA'S FIRST HYDROGEN PASSENGER TRAIN BEGINS OPERATIONS

One of India's biggest green transportation milestones was achieved in July 2026 with the launch of the country's first hydrogen fuel-cell passenger train between Jind and Sonipat. The project demonstrates India's commitment towards sustainable mobility and the National Green Hydrogen Mission. The train produces only water vapour as its emission and marks a significant step in clean rail transportation.

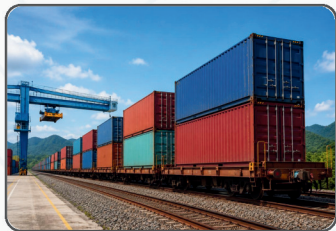
