National News (India)

- Nayara Energy cuts petrol prices by ₹5 per litre and diesel prices by ₹3 per litre at its retail outlets across India from 1 July 2026—the first significant retail fuel price cut in more than two years.
- Prices of Commercial LPG and Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) have also been reduced in India.
- State-run oil companies have not yet passed on the full benefit of lower crude oil prices to consumers, as they are still recovering losses incurred earlier.

Arrival of New High-Speed HAT 'C'/'U' Machine

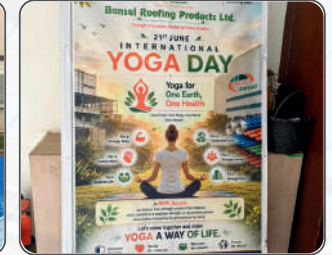
